## Art Lessons For Children, Ages 6-8, 9-12

### Supply List

For the first day of class, students will only need drawing supplies and paper, unless otherwise instructed by their teacher.

#### Drawing supplies:

1 box vine charcoal- soft

Two charcoal pencils -soft

1 large blending stomp

2 HB Pencils

2 kneaded erasers

1 large 18' x 24' Drawing Board with Clips (this is to hold the paper)

1 roll of artists tape (any neutral color is fine)

Portable Metal Pencil Sharpener

#### Paper:

11' x 14' Strathmore 400 Series sketch pad

11' x 14' Stonehenge Mutli-media Paper- Vellum Finish (any good brand will do, but make sure paper is at least 250 GSM thick). They will use this paper to both draw and do watercolor and acrylic on.

#### Painting Supplies:

Grey wax paper palette

Small Watercolor Kit

*Assorted Acrylic Colors: (These are not needed till later in the semester. Your teacher will let you know)*

Titanium White

Ivory Black

Yellow Ochre

Burnt Sienna

Cadmium Red

*Brushes* (synthetic sable may be substituted if cost is a factor):

Kolinsky Red Sable Brushes: Round # 0, 2, 3

Kolinsky Red Sable Brushes: Bright # 4, 6, 10

Bristle Brushes Filbert # 4, 3

Brush Holder- (optional, but very helpful for helping brushes last)

## *Canvases*

Most of our first paintings will be watercolor on paper. When its time to paint in acrylics, you will need:

2 cotton or linen panels, 11 x 14 or smaller, depending on what your teacher tells you to purchase.

## *Miscellaneous painting supplies:*

1 palette knife – trowel shaped

2 large plastic containers (about the size of canned goods) to hold water to clean brushes in, and to store them in while painting

1 Roll of Paper Towels (any brand will do).

1 Cotton rag (cut up old t-shirts are great).
